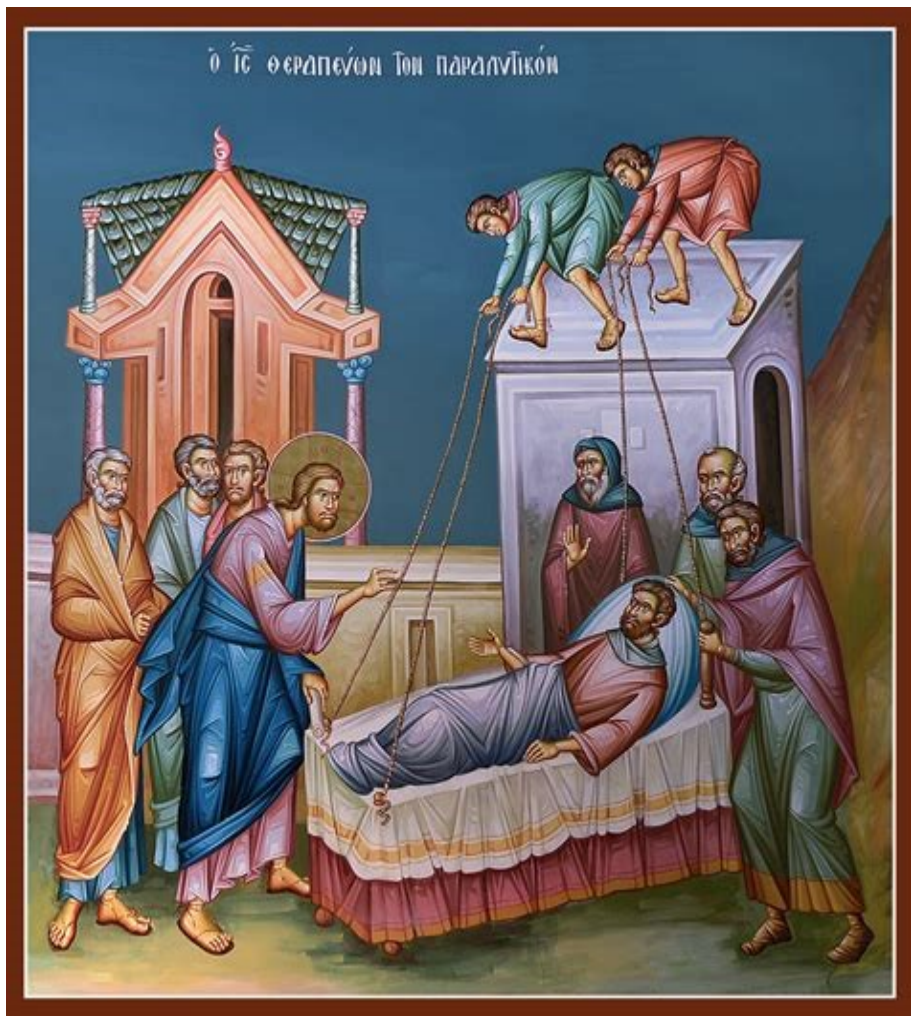

## SAINTS OF THE DAY:

GREAT-MARTYR PROCOPIUS OF CAESAREA IN PALESTINE;  
 NEW-MARTYRS THEOPHANES AND ANASTASIOS OF CONSTANTINOPLE;  
 VENERABLE THEOPHILOS THE MYRRH-STREAMING OF ST. BASIL KELLI  
 ON ATHOS; PROCOPIUS OF USTUG, FOOL-FOR-CHRIST

*During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion. The Eisodikon (Entrance Hymn) is "O come, let us worship... save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead..." After the Little Entrance, chant the apolytikia in the following order:*

### RESURRECTIONAL APOLYTIKION IN TONE FIVE

Let us believers praise and worship the Word; coeternal with the Father and the Spirit, born of the Virgin for our salvation. For, He took pleasure in ascending the Cross in the flesh to suffer death; and to raise the dead by His glorious Resurrection.

### APOLYTIKION OF ST. PROCOPIUS THE GREAT-MARTYR IN TONE FOUR

Thy Martyr, O Lord, in his courageous contest for Thee \* received as the prize the crowns of incorruption and life from Thee, our immortal God. \* For since he possessed Thy strength, he cast down the tyrants \* and wholly destroyed the demons' strengthless presumption. \* O Christ God, by his prayers, save our souls, since Thou art merciful.

### TROPARION OF ST. GEORGE IN TONE FOUR

As deliverer of captives and defender of the poor, healer of the infirm and champion of kings, victorious Great-martyr George, intercede with Christ our God that our souls may be saved.

### KONTAKION OF REGULAR SUNDAYS IN TONE TWO

O undisputed intercessor Christians, the mediatrix, who was unrejected by the Creator. Turn not away from the voice of our petitions, though we be sinners. Come to us with aid in time, who cry unto thee in faith, for thou art good. Hasten to us with intercessions, O Theotokos, who dost ever intercede for those who honor thee.

## THE EPISTLE

(For Sixth Sunday after Pentecost)

*Thou, O Lord, wilt preserve us and keep us from this generation.*

*Save me, O Lord, for the Godly man hath disappeared.*

### **The Reading from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Romans (12:6-14)**

Brethren, having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, in proportion to our faith; if service, in our serving; he who teaches, in his teaching; he who exhorts, in his exhortation; he who contributes, in liberality; he who gives aid, with zeal; he who does acts of mercy, with cheerfulness. Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; love one another with brotherly affection; outdo one another in showing honor. Never flag in zeal, be aglow with the Spirit, and serve the Lord. Rejoice in your hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer. Contribute to the needs of the saints, practice hospitality. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them.

## THE GOSPEL

(For Sixth Sunday of Matthew)

### **The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew (9:1-8)**

At that time, Jesus got into a boat, crossed over and came to His own city. And behold, they brought to Him a paralytic, lying on his bed; and when Jesus saw their faith He said to the paralytic, "Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven." And behold, some of the scribes said to themselves, "This man is blaspheming." But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins"—He then said to the paralytic—"Rise, take up your bed and go home." And he arose and went home. When the crowds saw it, they marveled, and they glorified God, Who had given such authority to men.

## *Reception of Holy Communion— Protocol and Etiquette*

During the Summer months or anytime there is NO Church School in session, children should remain in their pews with their family and approach for Holy Communion with their family. There is no need to line up in the back of the Sanctuary. And, of course, EVERYONE (children and adults) should return to their pews after the Reception of Holy Communion and remain until the Dismissal Prayers and Parish Announcements.

### *Church Etiquette Tips*

**“Lipstick, Perfume, & Chewing Gum”** – Lipstick (or gloss) should not be worn while taking Holy Communion, when venerating (kissing) the cross, an icon, the priest’s or bishop’s hand, or any sacred object. It is best not to wear it at all while attending liturgical services, but especially be mindful and blot lipstick (gloss) during the above-mentioned times. Hand-written icons have been ruined by lipstick; and even though the cross or spoon can usually be cleaned after everyone venerates, it’s not very considerate to those who follow. Also, please know that some people have a strong sensitivity to perfume, cologne, and even aftershave. If used, please use only a small amount. The Temple is already filled with the wonderful odor of incense arising to God as our prayers do. Lastly, chewing gum is never appropriate inside the Temple.
